In addition to the Rules and Regulations concerning Resell and Transfer possibilities and restrictions we would like to add that in the coming year 2009 there are six periods that might cause problems when a resell or a transfer is considered:

- the days around the weekend of Easter (9 April till 15 April 2009)
- the days around Queens Day and Liberation day (29 April till 7 May 2009)
- the days around Ascension-day (20 May till 26 May 2009)
- the days around the weekend of Pentecost (29 May till 3 June 2009)
- the days around Christmas (24 December 2009 till 29 December 2009)
- the days around New-year's day 2010 (30 December 2009 till 5 January 2010)

If you consider a request to resell or to transfer, we kindly advise you to make these requests earlier than in normal periods, due to the fact that it is possible to nominate altered amounts of capacity earlier than normal. As a result of this change in period we advise you to send in your resell/transfer requests before 8 April 2009 08h00, before 28 April 2009 08h00, before 19 May 2009 08h00, before 28 May 2009 08h00, before 23 December 2009 08h00 and before 29 December 2009 08h00.
